Set among 300 acres of glorious parkland, lakes, historic gardens and monuments, at the heart of the estate is the beautiful Grade I listed historic Mansion, with the more contemporary Pavilion, a short walk away. The world famous golf course encircles the hotel.

Stoke Park is a haven of tranquillity. Despite its proximity to major hubs, on entering the estate you transcend into a world of calmness and escapism, surrounded by breathtaking beauty.

The estate is currently undergoing an extensive renovation and planning process. During the planning process and renovation works, Stoke Park have opened up some of the facilities for events and stays, including the exquisitely refurbished Pavilion and our Championship Golf Course under a pay and play basis and exclusive hire, allowing for our guests to enjoy a luxurious one of a kind experience.

1000 YEARS OF PROUD HISTORY

- ★ Although our estate has a recorded history of over 1000 years, it was John Penn (1760-1834), a soldier, scholar and poet, who was responsible for most of what can still be seen at the estate today.
- ★ James Wyatt, architect to George III, worked on the development of The Mansion and monuments from 1790 to 1813. In 1791, Humphry Repton was commissioned to upgrade the Lancelot “Capability” Brown landscaping of the grounds.
- ★ The estate was used as a private residence until 1908. Nick “Pa” Lane Jackson, founder of The Corinthians, purchased the estate and created Stoke Park, Britain’s first Country Club. One of his first objectives was to commission the famous amateur golfer and course architect Harry Colt to design the golf course.
- ★ The first President was His Highness Prince Albert of Schleswig-Holstein and the first Vice-President was the Right Honourable Earl Howe. In his 1910 book, *The Golf Courses of the British Isles*, Bernard Darwin wrote: “Stoke Park is a beautiful estate, and there is very good golf to be played there. There are plenty of things to do besides playing golf. We may get very hot at lawn tennis or keep comparatively cool at bowls or croquet, or, coolest of all, we may sit on the terrace or in the garden and give ourselves wholly and solely to loafing.”

STOKE PARK IN THE MOVIES

Stoke Park has always had a close relationship with Pinewood Studios (5 miles away) and the British film industry.

Two James Bond movies; *Goldfinger* (1964) and *Tomorrow Never Dies* (1997), were filmed here at Stoke Park. The epic duel between James Bond and Auric Goldfinger is still considered to be the most famous games of golf in cinematic history.

The famous 'mini-break' and rowing scenes from *Bridget Jones's Diary* (2001) were filmed in the Great Hall, the Pennsylvania Suite and on the lakes with Hugh Grant, Renée Zellweger and Colin Firth.

In 2004, three movies were released featuring Stoke Park: *Wimbledon*, *Bride & Prejudice* and Matthew Vaughn's *Layer Cake*. Stoke Park features in many of *Layer Cake*'s scenes including the dramatic ending with Daniel Craig and Sienna Miller, filmed on the Mansion's front steps. Guy Ritchie's 2008 movie *RocknRolla* features the grass tennis courts and the 21st green.

In 2010, we welcomed Madonna to Stoke Park to film scenes of her Wallace Simpson biopic, *W.E.* and in 2012, Cameron Diaz and Oscar winner, Javier Bardem, shot scenes on the golf course for Ridley Scott's movie, *The Counselor*.

In 2019 Stoke Park made its debut in *The Crown*, welcoming Oscar winner, Olivia Coleman.

LOCATION

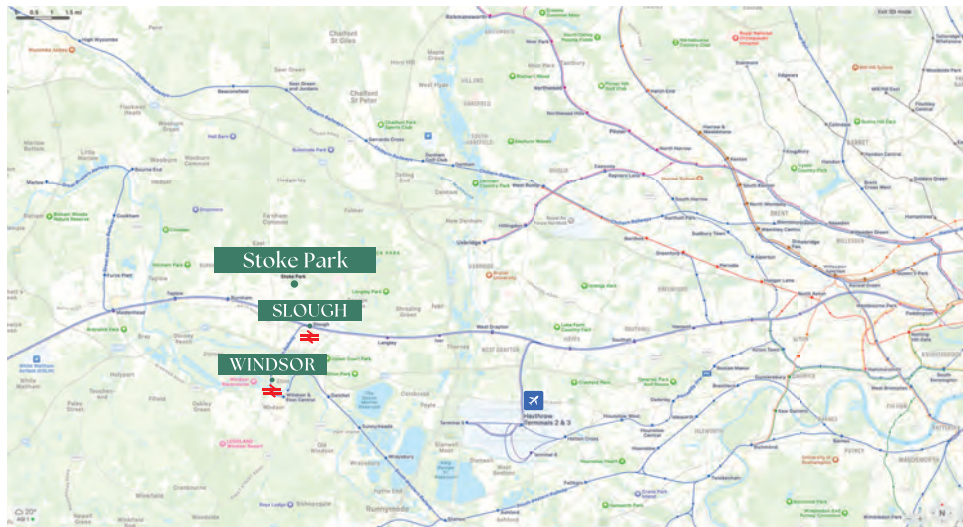
We are located in the village of Stoke Poges, in one of the most convenient locations in Britain: only 35 minutes from London, 7 miles from both London Heathrow and RAF Northolt (which can accommodate private flights).

With a helipad onsite, you can access London within 16 minutes.

Slough Station (Elizabeth Line) is 10 minutes away or Gerrards Cross Station only 15 minutes.

GOLF AT STOKE PARK

Encircling our 300 acre Buckinghamshire parkland estate, the famous 18 hole Championship golf course is undisputedly one of the finest parkland courses in the country. Created in 1908 by eminent golf architect Harry Colt, the course has been the inspiration for many of the world's most famous holes, including Augusta's infamous 16th. The course itself has seen many impressive rounds in its prestigious history, including James Bond's epic golfing duel in the 1964 classic 007 movie 'Goldfinger'.

The Custom technology offers complete customisation of your insoles. With a flat insole, the boot fitter heats the insoles and then moulds them. When it is placed on your footprint, the Custom insoles hugs the shape of your feet for the highest levels of comfort and support.

BIOMECAFORCE 3D AI FORCE PLATES

Unique to Stoke Park in the UK and created by world leading pioneer in biomechanics in sport, JJ Rivet, the force plates enable Stoke Park's Golf team of experts, a team which includes Rivet, to capture both Kinetic and Kinematic data of golfers and better understand their swing signatures. This information is vital in order to get to the correct swing diagnosis quickly and help the golfer to fulfil their potential.

TRACKMAN IO INDOOR GOLF SIMULATOR

This ceiling mounted optically enhanced radar tracking system (OERT) brings all the accuracy of the Trackman 4 to a pure golf simulator setting. This is Stoke Park's second dedicated coaching area for when the weather stops outdoor hitting. It has hundreds of courses which can be playing in a warm comfortable environment.

OUTDOOR SPACE

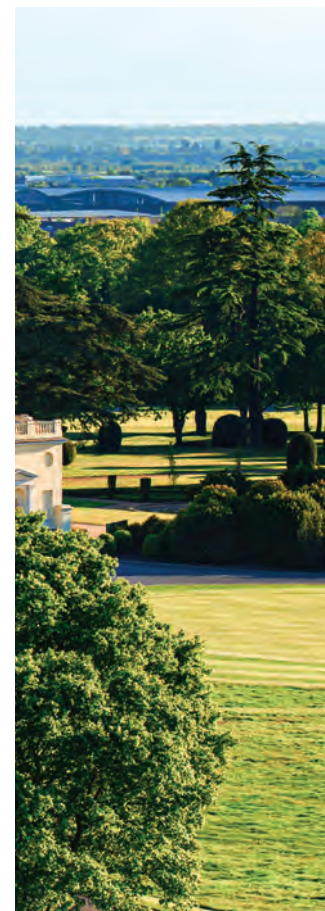
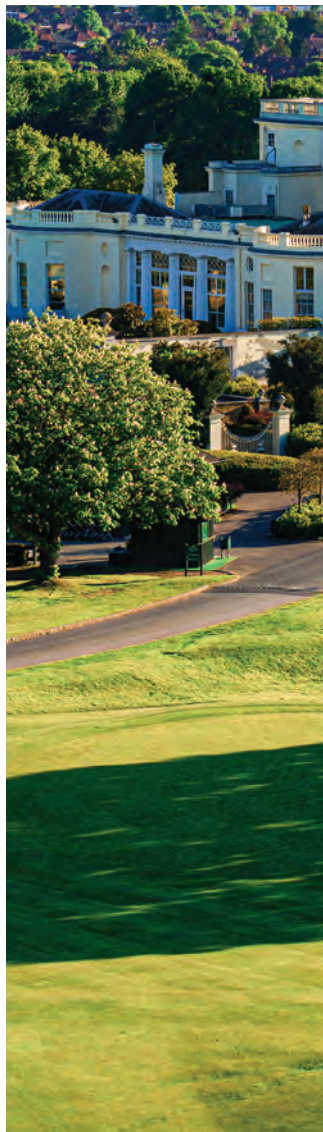
